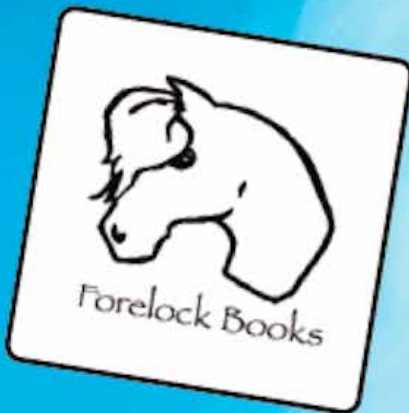
This book will, in places, make you laugh out loud. The characters are larger than life and you will quickly warm to Sahara and her mother, as they start a new adventure.
